First elected to Congress in 1992, Carolyn B. Maloney is recognized as a national leader with extensive accomplishments on financial services, national security, the economy, and women's issues. She is a senior member of both the House Financial Services Committee and the House Oversight and Government Reform Committee. As a champion for domestic and international women's issues, Maloney helped pass legislation on sex trafficking, mammograms for women on Medicare, and increased funding for law enforcement to process DNA rape kits. Her legislation to create Women's Health Offices in five Federal agencies was part of the landmark health care reform legislation signed by President Obama.
